

Notice of Technical Visit – Rainwater Harvesting System at Shui Chuen O Public Housing Development

Building on the rainwater harvesting techniques, an integrated model was applied to the Shui Chuen O Estate which is a public housing development project, with a view to reducing the development's reliance on Dong Jiang basin for irrigation by 50 percent. The solution integrated stormwater treatment measures into landscape to provide an onsite sustainable source of water; and at the same time created an aesthetic amenity, reduced flood risk and alleviated the burden on stormwater drainage by improving the quality of runoff entering the ecosystem.
