## **Technical Visit**

### **Physical Model for Kai Tak River Improvement Projects**

Kai Tak River, which is a major drainage channel in East Kowloon area, runs along Choi Hung Road to discharge the collected storm water and the treated effluent from the Tolo Harbour Effluent Export Scheme to Victoria Harbour. To improve the drainage capacity of the River and mitigate flood risk, the Drainage Services Department implemented improvement works to increase the drainage capacity of the River. A physical model study was conducted to evaluate the hydraulic performance of the upgraded river. This technical visit will provide an opportunity to visit the physical model used for the river improvement works and understand the Kai Tak River Improvement Projects.
